



## US Business Leadership Network Tapped by Labor's Office of Disability Employment Policy for Strategic Alliance to Promote Employment of Americans with Disabilities

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WASHINGTON, DC (September 24, 2008) – The US Business Leadership Network (USBLN®) today announced that it entered into a Strategic Alliance with the U.S. Department of Labor's Office of Disability Employment Policy (ODEP) to promote employment of people with disabilities nationwide. The USBLN® is only the third organization to receive this prestigious honor, along side the Society for Human Resource Management (SHRM) and CVS/Caremark.

On September 12<sup>th</sup>, Kemp signed the alliance agreement with ODEP Assistant Secretary **Neil Romano**. According to ODEP this collaboration will provide USBLN® members and other employers with information, guidance and access to resources that will help them to recruit, hire and advance workers with disabilities.

Through such alliances, ODEP partners with organizations to develop model policies, programs and strategies, as well as forge new channels for training, education and outreach. The agency's Alliance Initiative is open to businesses, trade and professional associations, labor unions, educational institutions, government agencies at all levels and others.
