WASHINGTON, DC (December 3, 2012) – "Removing barriers to create an inclusive and accessible society for all" is the theme for the 2012 United Nations' International Day of Persons with Disabilities which is annually celebrated today, December 3. In support of opportunities for people with disabilities around the world, the USBLN[®] has issued a letter in support of the ratification of the Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (CRPD) which recognizes that the existence of barriers constitutes a central component of disability. Under the Convention, disability is an evolving concept that "results from the interaction between persons with impairments and attitudinal and environmental barriers that hinder their full and effective participation in society on an equal basis with others."
