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WASHINGTON, DC (July 25, 2014) – As we celebrate the 24th anniversary of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), the US Business Leadership Network[®] (USBLN[®]) is excited about the many recent productive partnerships that have been forged resulting in cutting edge events and initiatives to fulfill the promise of the ADA of full inclusion of people with disabilities in every aspect of life, including employment.

On June 26, 2014, in partnership with the American Association of People with Disabilities (AAPD), the USBLN unveiled the first **Annual Disability Equality Index**SM (**DEI**SM). Created by the DEI Advisory Committee, a diverse group of business leaders, policy experts, and disability advocates, the DEI is an online benchmarking tool that offers businesses the opportunity to receive an objective score, on a scale of zero to 100, on their disability inclusion policies and practices. It is an aspirational, educational, recognition tool that is intended to help companies identify opportunities for continued improvement on their disability inclusion initiatives, as well as, help build a company's reputation as an employer of choice. The first Annual DEI survey will launch in October 2014 during the 2014 USBLN Annual National Conference & Biz2Biz Expo. USBLN Executive Director Jill Houghton and **National Council on Independent Living (NCIL)** Executive Director Kelly Buckland signed a strategic alliance agreement to formalize their mutual collaboration to drive disability inclusion awareness and to advance, improve and expand employment outcomes for individuals with disabilities.
